2. The candidates must read the prospectus carefully before filling the Admission Form. Attested copies of the certificates / documents are to be attached with the Admission form. Duly attested photographs must be attached with the Form. Migration certificate be attached if the candidate has passed his/her B.A./M.A. or any other examination, other than from K.U.K.
3. Nothing contained in this prospectus would be construed to convey sanction or cited as an authority for which University Regulations in Calendar Vol. I, II and the relevant Rules in Vol. III, alone are applicable.
4. If the concerned authorities are not satisfied with the character, past behaviour and antecedents of a candidate, they may refuse to admit him/her to law course in order to ensure academic standards, discipline and peaceful atmosphere in the College. The Vice-Chancellor may cancel the admission of any student on the recommendation of the Principal-Director of the College.
5. The Application Form, if sent by Post must be sent through Registered Post/Speed Post/ Courier. College does not owe any liability for delay in delivery or non delivery.
6. **Late or incomplete application and applications not submitted on the prescribed form will not be considered and no further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.**

## About the University

Kurukshetra University was established in 1956 as a Unitary Teaching and Residential University. Initially starting only with the Department of Sanskrit, it has grown into a multi-faculty University, teaching various subjects in the Faculties of Arts and Languages; Science; Social Sciences; Indic Studies; Education; Engineering and Technology; Law; Commerce and Management; Ayurvedic Medicine; Medical and Dental Sciences. From the 30th June, 1974, the character of the University changed into an affiliating one, with the admission of all the colleges in the State of Haryana to the privilege of University. The colleges at Rohtak were withdrawn from this University on 1 st May, 1976 and affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak. Subsequently with effect from 8th November, 1978 the remaining colleges of District Rohtak and the Colleges in the Districts of Bhiwani, Gurgaon, Mohindergarh and Sonapat were also withdrawn and affiliated to Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak. At present the University consists of 10 Faculties comprising of 40 Teaching Departments and 148 affiliated colleges situated in the Districts of Ambala, Panipat, Kaithal, Jind, Hisar, Fatehabad, Sirsa, Yamuna Nagar, Kamal, Kurukshetra and Panchkula.

The campus of the University sprawls across 400 acres of land against an idyllic background of rural charm and is situated at a distance of 4 kms. from the Kurukshetra Railway Station. The site near the sacred tank of Kurukshetra was chosen by the sponsors of the University for its historical and spiritual significance.

### Rail and Road Connections

Kurukshetra Railway Station is almost midway between Karnal and Ambala on the Delhi-Ambala section of the Northern Railway. All major Express and Mail trains halt at this station. Convenient direct bus services is available from Amritsar, Delhi, Hardwar, Chandigarh, Ambala and most of the other towns in Haryana.

### Eligibility

#### LL.B. (Professional) 3-year Degree Course

Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree Examination of the Kurukshetra University or any Examination recognised as equivalent thereto, with English as

one of the subjects in the qualifying examination and with atleast 45% marks in the aggregate (40% for SC/ST candidates) in either of these Degree (One-Year Degree/Diploma Courses like, D.P.Ed., M.Ed., B.Ed., B.Lib. Sc., etc. shall not be considered as equivalent to Bachelor's Degree).

#### B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) 5 Year Integrated Course

- a) A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 standard) from The Board of School Education Haryana or an Examination recognized as equivalent thereto, with **45% marks** in the aggregate with five subjects including the subject of English shall be eligible to seek admission in the first semester of B.A.LL.B (Hons.) 5 - Year Integrated Course.

**Explanation :** The candidate who have obtained 10+2 through open University System directly without having any basic qualification i.e., Matric/Secondary/10+2 are not eligible for admission in the B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) 5-Year Integrated Course.

- b) The minimum eligibility condition in the case of SC/ST Candidates shall be 40% marks in the qualifying Examination with English as one of the subjects. (There shall be no rounding of percentage of marks of the qualifying Examination i.e.40% and 50% means exact percentage. Thus, 39.5% and above does not mean 40% or 44.5% and above does not mean 45%.
- c) 5% relaxation in minimum eligibility condition for Blind/Physically and Visually Handicapped candidates.
- d) On July 31st, 2010 the candidate seeking admission, shall not be more than 20 years of age (22 in case of SC/ST and Other Backward Communities candidates).
- e) The candidates who have appeared for the final year of 10+2 Examination in 2010 and whose results have not been declared may also apply at their own risk and responsibility subject to the fulfillment of the above-mentioned eligibility conditions on the date of counseling.

CANDIDATES WHO PLACED COMPARTMENT IN THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED ADMISSION TO THE COURSE EVEN PROVISIONALLY.

## Selection Procedure

### LL.B. Part-I (Professional) 3-Year Degree Course

### B.A. LL.B. Part-I (Professional) 5 Year Degree Course

Admission to First Year of LL.B. (Professional) 3 Year and 5 Year Course, shall be made on the basis of Merit of Qualifying Examination as per rules, other terms and conditions of the University.

### Reservation, Distribution of Seats for LL.B. 3 Years Course/LL.B. 5 Year Course

- (A) Reservation of seats for Bonafide Residents of Haryana  
The seats shall be reserved for the categories as under :

If the seats reserved for Physically Handicapped persons remain vacant due to non-availability of suitable handicapped candidates, it may be offered to ex-servicemen and their wards (1%) and dependents of Freedom Fighter (1%).

- (B) Distribution of seats  
The seats shall be distributed as under :

- (50% of the seats earmarked for bonafide residents of Haryana will be reserved for the categories as mentioned at (A) above, as per State Government policy and remaining 50% seats will be filled from amongst General Category candidates.)

**Note:** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from a University in the State of Haryana will be deemed to be Residents of Haryana and will not be required to submit certificates of bonafide residents of Haryana.

## IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. The Reservation of seats is as per the Reservation Policy of the Haryana Government and is subject to any change/Amendment by the State government from time to time.
2. Certificate of SC and BC Block A & B to be submitted by the candidates on the proformas alongwith the Admission Forms. The BC candidates (Block A & B) for benefit of reservation shall also have to furnish an affidavit on the prescribed proforma to the effect that he/she is not covered under the criteria of creamy layer. The said affidavit shall be furnished by both father and mother of the candidate.
3. Dependent of Freedom Fighters of Haryana are required to submit a certificate from the concerned Deputy Commissioner.
4. Only candidates having permanent disability of not less than 40% (being otherwise fit for admission to the course) will be considered for admission as physically handicapped. Disability certificate should be issued by the Chief Medical Officer of the concerned District. However, the certificate shall be subject to verification by a Medical Board of the College constituted for the purpose and the decision of the Board shall be final.
5. Ex-Servicemen and their Wards of Haryana are required to submit the certificate from the concerned District Soldier Board.
6. Selected candidates who fail to deposit their dues by the stipulated period shall not be considered in subsequent lists.
7. All the eligible candidates of Haryana will be considered for the seats under category (B) irrespective of whether or not they belong to category (A).
8. All the eligible candidates, whether from Haryana or from reserved category, may also compete for seats allocated under open category.
9. The percentage of seats reserved under (A) category shall not be changed.
10. If the number of seats in any particular category is not a round figure, 0.5 or above will be taken as one and less than 0.5 shall be ignored. However number of reserved seats excess 50% of the total seats even if a fraction of 0.5 or more is to be ignored.
11. Raging in any form shall be prohibited and strict legal action will be taken as per Law.

In view of the Letter no. ACM-3/Adm 13/07/8310-509 dated 21-5-07 the weightages for the purpose of merit for LL.B shall be prepared in the following way.

## Weight ages for the Purpose of Merit for LL.B.

Candidates who are eligible for admission will be entitled to Weightages as given below:

- (A) Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from the Universities in the Haryana State : 5 Marks
- (B) Recipients of National Talent Award from the N.C.E.R.T. : 5 Marks
- (C) Candidates having consistently good academic record i.e., throughout First Class from First Public Examination to qualifying examination. : 5 Marks
- (D) N.C.C. Cadets who have passed the C/G-II Certificate (No weightage will be given for Civil Defence Service) : 5 Marks

**OR**

Student who have been recommended or commended (i.e. have obtained 1 st or 2nd position) at the Inter-Zonal or Inter-University or Inter-State Level Youth festivals organised by State Govt./ University competitions either individually or as members of a team.

**OR**

Sportsmen who have won 1st or 2nd or 3rd position at the University/State Level Tournaments organised by State Govt./University in individual Events or team Games or have actually participated in the Inter-University or National Level Competition.

**OR**

Holders of Certificate of Merit for N.S.S. awarded by the University.

**Criteria for award of University N.S.S. Merit Certificate will be as under:**

- 1 . N.S.S. Volunteer who has completed 240 hours of regular activities in the period of two years and attended one annual special Camp (of at least 10 days duration) and
2. One who has donated blood at least twice or has made at least four illiterate literate. This shall have to be certified by the Principal alongwith the names and addresses of the illiterates or has shown exemplary act of courage or bravery by saving life like drowning, fire, natural calamities or man made calamities. In case of N.S.S. Volunteers from other Universities

located out side Haryana, one has to become eligible by way of becoming at par with the condition as required under Sr. No .. 1 and 2 of the above criteria laid down for University Merit Certificate.

N.S.S. weightage will not be allowed to the students who have only N.S.S. participation certificate given by the College Principal.

**OR**

For the students instructors/volunteers of colleges maintained / recognised by the Kurukshetra University for running Adult Education Centres/engaged under M.P.F.L.

(The above weightage under Adult Education Scheme will be given on the basis of the Certificate issued jointly by the Principal of the College affiliated or maintained by Kurukshetra University and Hony. Director, C.A.C.E.E., K.U. KURUKSHETRA.

**Provided that :**

- (a) The weightage of marks for the purpose of the merit will be added to percentage of marks of entrance test and qualifying examination.
- (b) The total weightage for merit (A to D) above shall not exceed 10 marks.
- (c) The weightage for the purpose of merit under Clause (D) above shall be given only if the candidate has obtained required certificate/Distinction during the entire course of the qualifying examination on the basis of which he is seeking admission to the course. For example, if a candidate is seeking admission on the basis of B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com. Examination, he will be given weightage under this cause only if he has obtained certificate of distinction, during I, II & III of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. Course.
- (d) Weightage for sports will be given only in respect of Tournaments in the following games/events arranged by the University/Inter-University Sports Board or by a State/ National Organisation. No Game or event which is not recognised by the Association of Indian Universities shall be considered.

**Games for Boys and Girls :**

Athletics including Cross Country; Badminton; Basket-ball; Cricket; Cycling; Gymnastics; Hockey; Kho-Kho; Shooting; Swimming including Water-Polo and Diving; Tennis; Table-Tennis; Volley-Ball; Hand-Ball; Kabaddi of National Style; Football; Chess; Boxing; Judo; Weight Lifting; Yoga; Best Physique; Wrestling; Power Lifting; Karball, Softball and Net-ball.

## Character Certificate

Character Certificate is essential and Admission Forms NOT accompanied by Character Certificate shall not be accepted. The details of character certificate to be furnished shall be as under :

**(a) Private Candidates :**

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as private candidates should submit their Character Certificate duly signed by a First Class Magistrate.

**(b) Gap in Study:**

Male candidates who have gaps in their academic career after the Qualifying Examination, must furnish a gap certificate in the form of affidavit or certificate from the employer and should also furnish separately Character Certificate of gap period from a First Class Magistrate.

**(c) Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as regular students:**

Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as regular students in 2010 must submit the Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended as per specimen attached.

## Other Certificates

- (a) Certificate of Last Public Examination passed;
- (b) Certificate showing marks obtained and maximum marks in each subject of all the Years in the last Public examination;
- (c) Matriculation or equivalent examination certificate in support of date of birth;
- (d) Certificate of distinction in sports, if any;
- (e) Certificate on the proforma in case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/Backward Classes (Block 'A' and 'B'), if applicable;
- (f) Residence Certificate in the case of candidates claiming to be bona fide residents of Haryana if applicable;

**Applications, which do not have the above documents, will be treated as 'incomplete' and such applications will not be entertained.**

Candidates selected for admission will be required to pay their 1st installment of fee and other charges at the time of admission and if any candidate failed to do so his/her seat will be offered to the next candidate.

## IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. No Admission form received after the last date and specified time for the purpose shall be considered under any circumstances.
2. If the last date for receipt of admission forms falls on a holiday or that day is declared holiday by the University, the next working day will be considered as the last date for the purpose.

## More About the Admissions

Candidates whose names appear in the merit-list will be considered eligible for admission within the prescribed time. Such candidates will have to present themselves at the scheduled date, time and place for verification of their original documents. No excuse of any sort including late arrival of buses, trains or any other mode of transport and claims of having been sick for not presenting themselves in time shall be entertained. After checking the original documents selected candidates will be given admission slips. Thereupon, they shall be required to deposit requisite fee either in cash with fee clerk of the college or by way of crossed Demand Draft drawn in the favour of Principal-Director, Chhaju Ram Law College, Hisar payable at Hisar. It is advisable that students should keep a photocopy thereof. However, it is to be noted that requisite fee has to be paid on the day of counselling (Admission) itself and no accommodation shall be made in any case. After obtaining Section allotment slip they will get their names entered in the Attendance Register of the concerned teacher. If any candidate does not get the Section allotment slip from the office of the college depositing Roll Number slip within the time fixed for depositing the fee, his or her admission will be treated as cancelled even though he or she may have deposited his or her fee. His or her seat will be treated as vacant and will be allotted to the next candidate. Such a candidate will himself be responsible for his/her non-admission. Change in section will not be permitted once it has been allotted.

A student of LL.B. (Professional) course shall not be allowed to take admission simultaneously in any other course.

It shall be the responsibility of the candidates to remain in touch with the college and ascertain the progress of admissions. They should not wait / depend on receipt of communication from the college.

## IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS :

1. No individual intimation will be sent to the candidates for admission purposes. All candidates must find out their merit position in the Merit list displayed on the Notice Board of the Chhaju Ram Law College, Hisar on the prescribed date & time.
2. The candidates seeking admissions for a particular category must be present in the Chhaju Ram Law College, Hisar on the respective dates given above. The admissions will be made on the spot and dues will be accepted at the same time. Therefore, the candidates must bring with them the dues to be paid by them.
3. **The candidates must bring with them their all original documents on the date of admission.**

### Eligibility Certificate

The eligibility for admission to B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) 5 Year Integrated Course will be checked by the Principal-Director, Chhaju Ram Law College, Hisar at their own level and after provisional admission, the General office of the College will check all documents of admitted candidates and fill up the eligibility certificate.

### General Rules of the Course

#### LL.B. (Professional) 3 Year Course Course/B.A. LL.B. 5 Year Integrated Course

1. The duration of the course leading to the degree of Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) Professional shall be 3 Year/5 Year Course.
2. A student is required to attend not less than 70% of the lectures delivered in each of the subjects/papers and also in the tutorials and practical classes, including moot courts.
3. The medium of instructions as well as of the examination shall be English.
4. The examinations shall be held semesterwise as per the dates to be notified by the Controller of Examinations, K.U.K.
5. Practical Training of students shall be inbuilt part of curriculum.

### Tuition Fee

- (1) Tuition fee to be charged from casual students is mentioned in the Regulations relating to admission of casual students.

- (2) Tuition Fee and other monthly dues will be payable for 12 months in a Year, i.e. from June to May.

Dues must be paid on the dates notified, otherwise late fee fine per day, excluding holidays, shall be charged. The names of the defaulters shall stand struck off the rolls, if the dues are not paid till the end of the month, unless permission is obtained from the Principal/Director of the College to make payment at a later date within the next month. Students may be re-admitted with the permission of the Principal-Director of the College on payment of the prescribed fee alongwith the arrear of the fee and/or fines, provided that the Principal-Director of the College is satisfied that if re-admitted, the student will not fall short of the requisite percentage of lectures etc. A candidate who attends any classes during the period when his or her name remains struck off the rolls, shall not be given any credit for lectures, which he may have attended during the period in question.

### Important Instructions for Candidates for Filling the Admission Form :

1. All entries in this form must be in the candidate's own handwriting. Entries must be clear and legible.
2. The Application Form must be completed in all respect. No column should be left unfilled. If any information sought is not applicable to the Candidate, the words "N.A." should be entered against that column.
3. A number of documents like copies of University/Board certificates, photographs, certificates claiming special status, etc. need to be attached to this application. Without the required documents being attached, the application is liable to be rejected as incomplete.
4. Specimen of forms in which various certificates are to be submitted are given in the prospectus. Only certificates in prescribed proforma will be acceptable.
5. All copies of University / Board Certificates, Photographs and character certificate etc., must be attested by the Head of the Institution last attended or by a Class-I Gazetted Officer or by an Officer of the University not below the rank of Assistant Registrar. The full name of the attesting Officer and the official seal must be clearly legible on the certificate.
6. The Check-list of documents printed in this prospectus should be carefully read and the total number of documents enclosed with the application should be clearly mentioned.

**Note:** The candidates should understand that the admission, if any, granted by the College will be provisional and subject to cancellation if any statement made in this application is found to be incorrect.

Copy of letter No.62/17/95-6 GSI dated 3rd Oct., 1996/No. 62/32/2000-6 GS/dated 23-05-2003 and No.62/27/2003- 6 GS/dated 29.07.2003 received from the Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, to all Heads of Departments, Commissioners Ambala, Rohtak, Gurgaon and Hisar Division etc.

### **Subject:- Bona fide residents of Haryana - Guidelines regarding.**

I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Government letters on the subject noted above vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for the purpose of admission to educational institution (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgement delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain vs Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984/SC/1421, wherein it has been held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Resident' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government and it has been decided to revise the Government instructions. Henceforth the following categories of persons, would be eligible for the grant of Resident Certificate:

- (i) Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination, for selection in an institution, from a school/college in Haryana;
- (ii) Children/wards (if parents are not living) dependents :-
  - (a) of the regular employees of Haryana State posted in or outside Haryana State or working on deputation;
  - (b) of, the regular employees of the statutory bodies/corporations established by or under an act of the State of Haryana who are posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana or outside Haryana.
  - (c) of the regular employees of the Government of India posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of the Haryana Government.
- (iii) Children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of persons who after retirement have permanently settled in Haryana and draw their pensions from the treasuries situated in the state of Haryana.
- (iv) Children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of pensioners of Haryana Govt. irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a State other than Haryana or he has settled after retirement in or

outside Haryana;

- (v) Children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of persons who have permanent home in Haryana and include persons who have been residing in Haryana for a period of not less than 15 years or who have permanent home in Haryana but on account of their occupation they are living outside Haryana.
  - (vi) The wives of such persons who are bona fide residents of Haryana irrespective of the fact that they had belonged to any other State before marriage;
  - (vii) Persons who were born in Haryana and produce a certificate of the effect, provided that the parents/guardians (if parents are not living), persons belonging to any of the above mentioned categories are :
    - (a) Citizen of India
    - (b) produce an affidavit to the effect that they or their children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents have not obtained the benefit of domicile in any other State.
  - (viii) Children and wards of the accredited journalists residing at Chandigarh and recognized by Government of Haryana.
2. All candidates claiming to be bonafide residents of Haryana should produce a **Haryana Resident Certificate** signed by the District Magistrate/General Assistant to Deputy Commissioner or Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil) of the District/sub-division/Tehsildar of Revenue to which the candidates belong. Resident Certificates in respect of the children/wards/dependents of Haryana Govt. employees who are posted at Chandigarh, Delhi or else where or in respect of the children/wards/dependents of Pensioners of Haryana Government, or in respect of the Children/Wards/Dependents of the employees of Government of India posted at Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of Haryana Government, or in respect of Children/Wards/Dependents of the employees and retirees of the statutory bodies/corporations of Haryana established by or under an act of the State of Haryana or a Central Act and located at Chandigarh, Haryana or out side Haryana should be issued by their respective Heads of Departments.
  3. Candidates seeking admission in educational institutions (including medical and technical institutions) located in Haryana, may not be required to produce Resident Certificate if they have passed the examination from a school/college situated in Haryana. For this purpose, the certificate of the Principal/Headmaster from concerned institution where the children/wards

studied last should be considered sufficient. The Principal/Headmaster of the Institution shall be competent to issue such certificate which should be sufficient.

4. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of claim that he belongs to the state of Haryana but at any subsequent time it is discovered that his claim was false, the student shall be removed from the institution and all fees and other dues paid up to the date of removal shall be confiscated. The Principal/Headmaster may take such other action against the student and his/her parents/guardians as he may deem proper in the circumstances of any particular case.

6.	Certificate for claiming reservation if candidate is SC/ST/BC/PH/ ExM/FFD etc.
7.	Gap year Affidavit, if there is a gap in admission to LL.B ·1 st year duly issued by First Class Magistrate.
8.	Migration Certificate if candidate has passed his/her B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com./M.A./ M.Sc/M.Com etc from any other University other than K.U.K. in original.

Candidates are advised to bring all the documents in original along with requisite attested photocopies with them. If any documents is found deficient, he will not be admitted in LL.B course of this college.
